- Oil Paints

- Brushes
 - 12 mm Bright: [Link to Blick](#)

- Palette knife: [Link to Blick](#)
- Palette:
 - Any flat surface works. You can buy a wooden or a plastic one at an art supply store, use an old baking sheet, or even a piece of glass with white paper taped to the back and tape on the edges of the glass to avoid cuts. Whatever you choose your palette should be roughly 9" x 12"
- Turpenoid (odorless paint thinner), 8oz: [Link to Blick](#)

Other Supplies:

- Rag, a rag made from an old sheet or a t-shirt is my favorite but any old rag will do
- Painting smock/old clothes, anything you don't mind getting oil paint onto. Paint can be hard to wash out if you don't get it right away
- 2 Re-sealable jars, like a mason jar. This is the jar we are putting our turpenoid in so make sure it doesn't leak.
- HB or no. 2 pencil, eraser, and sketching paper
- Dawn dish soap or Murphy's oil soap for washing brushes
