

Portraits in Watercolor

Supplies needed: If you have your own painting supplies, please bring what you have. Are you new to watercolor painting? Here is what you'll need:

Watercolor paint: In tubes please purchase the **4ml tube size**

Colors needed are:

French Ultramarine Blue
Cadmium Yellow
Aureolin Yellow
Gamboge Yellow
Alizarin Crimson (Red)
Cadmium Red Deep
Permanent Rose (red)

If you are new to painting and you do not want to purchase a lot of paint, you can choose on blue, one yellow, and one red to start.

Watercolor Brushes:

Rounds (#4, #6 and #8)

Other Supplies:

1-16x20 sheet of 140lb cold press watercolor paper: D'Arches Natural White, Cason or Strathmore (Cut or fold and tear into 4-8"x10" pieces)
Plastic Watercolor Palette/Tray – Round plastic tray with small bowls in them for mixing.
Box of Kleenex
Paper towels
2 – 3 Containers for water (Large cups, Mayonnaise jars, etc)
2B Drawing pencil
Ballpoint pen
Tape (painter's tape or watercolor tape)
1-11x14 3/16" thick, or thicker, piece of foam core
