## **Materials List:**

- \* try to find the most unlikely, outlandish, unusual item that you have lying around. It can be something that you want to make into a piece of jewelry or something that you would like to present as a challenge to other participants to make into a piece of jewelry. Choose something fun but also not offensive, please.
  - \* Jewelry-making tools: round nose pliers, chain nose pliers, flat nose pliers, (flush) cutters.
  - \* Wire 5 to 10 feet of 20-gauge colored copper practice wire
  - \* Beads: a 15-inch strand or a collection of your own beads
  - \* Sharpie marker
  - \* Ruler
  - \* Soft cloth/polishing cloth
  - \* Safety glasses (optional but highly encouraged)
  - \* Beadboard (optional)
  - \* Clasps and ear wires will be discussed in class and can be purchased later if needed
